To Whom It May Concern:

I represent [REDACTED] Enclosed please find an I-246 application for a Stay of Removal for Ms. [REDACTED] She is requesting a Stay of Removal until she is granted U Nonimmigrant Status.

Ms. [REDACTED] requests a Stay because they are applicants for U Nonimmigrant Status. In addition, Ms. [REDACTED] has factors that support a discretionary determination, and no factors that are so negative as to preclude a Stay of Removal. Ms. [REDACTED]'s positive factors include:

Application for U Nonimmigrant Status. On August 16, 2016, our office submitted I-918 Petitions for U-visa Nonimmigrant Status for Ms. [REDACTED] I am certain that her U-visa petition will be approved, as Ms. [REDACTED] was the victim of rape and extensively cooperated with district attorney in the prosecution of the case. I am confident of this assessment because our office has submitted what accounts for 5-10% of the total amount of U-visa petitions submitted and we have a 99% approval rate.

I understand that Immigration Customs Enforcement continues to use the September 25, 2009 US ICE Interoffice Memorandum entitled, "*Guidance Regarding U Nonimmigrant Status (U visa) Applicants in Removal Proceedings or with Final Orders of Deportation or Removal*," by Principal Legal Advisor Peter S. Vincent, as guidance in these matters. Specifically, the Guidance states:

Upon receiving a stay request from an alien with a pending U visa petition, the local DRO office must contact its local OCC to request a *prima facie* determination from USCIS's Vermont Service Center (VSC). DRO should allow USCIS a minimum of five (5) business days to make a *prima facie* determination. During this time, the FOD should not deport or remove the alien, although DRO may continue to secure the necessary documents to effect the alien's removal in the event USCIS finds that the alien is not *prima facie* eligible for a U visa or denies the petition on the merits. The VSC will e-mail the respective Field Office DRO stay mailbox and the local OCC point of contact with the results of the *prima facie* review or a copy of the decision notice.

If USCIS finds that the alien has established *prima facie* eligibility, the FOD, working in conjunction with the local OCC will adjudicate the stay request. The FOD should view a stay request favorably, unless serious adverse factors exist, as outlined above. If the FOD finds that serious adverse factors exist and is inclined to deny the stay request despite the USCIS *prima facie* eligibility finding, the FOD must provide a summary of the case to DROHQ for further review."

As noted above, I am confident that USCIS's Vermont Service Center will issue a *prima facie* eligibility determination for Ms. [REDACTED] U Status application. Our office submitted her U-visa application on August 16, 2016, and we are still waiting for VSC to adjudicate her case.

There are no adverse factors in Ms. [REDACTED] case that weigh against approval of a stay. According to the Guidance, "Serious adverse factors include the following: (1) national security concerns; (2) evidence that the alien is a human rights violator; (3) evidence that the alien has engaged in significant immigration fraud; (4) evidence that the alien has a significant criminal history; and (5) any significant public safety concerns."

(1) *Ms. [REDACTED] has no criminal record, is not a threat to national security or public safety, and is not a human rights violator. The only reason that she is currently in proceedings is because she was detained at the border. She is only at risk of expedited removal because her most recent entry was within the last two years.*

(2) *USCIS has not denied Ms. [REDACTED] applications on the merits. As I indicate above, Ms. [REDACTED] submitted her U-visa application on August 16 2016, and the application is still pending at Vermont Service Center.*

Positive factors relevant to prosecutorial discretion. Ms. [REDACTED] is a victim of a serious crime, rape, who substantially assisted the Kings County District Attorney's office in the prosecution of her assailant. As a result of her cooperation, the defendant was convicted of rape.

Ms. [REDACTED] suffered substantial emotional trauma as a result of her rape. Ms. [REDACTED] needs continued access to the U.S. health system and the protection of the United States law enforcement as a result of the crime committed against her.

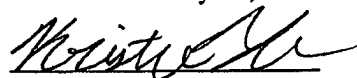

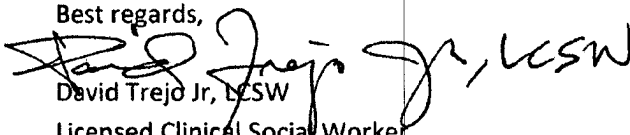

I, [REDACTED] declare under the penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. I was born on [REDACTED] in Pihuamo, Jalisco, Mexico.
2. I respectfully request that a stay of removal be granted, because I was the victim of a violent crime. I need to remain in the United States with my family where I am supported and where I can continue to recover from the crime that I experienced. I need the continued protection of the United States laws. I believe it is in the national and public interest to allow me to stay in the United States while I wait for my U Visa application to be granted.
3. I have lived in the United States since 2007, when I was ten years old. On January 25, 2013 I was raped by someone I knew from my school. This was a very traumatic situation for me. In June 2014, I returned to Mexico for a time.
4. But after a while, it was impossible for me to stay in Mexico. I missed my family so much and I needed to be with them. I was desperate to return to the United States. On May 15, 2015 I attempted to reenter the United States. I was detained as a minor and then released to my parents.
5. Since I have returned to the United States, I have finally started to recover from what happened to me. I am finally getting my life together. It has helped a lot to be with my family.
6. Also I am now the mother of a U.S. citizen child, [REDACTED], who was born [REDACTED] 2016. I am [REDACTED] primary caregiver and the person who takes care of him. It is very important to me that I be able to stay with my son. I can't imagine what would happen if I lost my family again or what I would do if I had to go back to Mexico.
7. I filed an application for U Nonimmigrant Status in August 2016. I am currently waiting for a response to my application. I do not know how long I will have to wait for a response to my case.
