



Immigrant Visa Consular Processing for Relative of U-1

(Relative of U-1 AOS applicant who never had U status and is currently OUTSIDE the United States, using INA § 245(m)(3))

U-1 AOS Petitioner files Form I-929 for Derivative Beneficiary with USCIS (usually with the Petitioner's I-485 or after I-485 approved)



Receive I-929 approval from USCIS after U-1 Petitioner's AOS is approved



USCIS Sends I-929 Approval and file to NVC



When payment is posted (can take up to a week) submit I-864W and DS-260



Pay IV and Affidavit of Support Fees via CEAC website



Receive "Welcome" email and/or letter with NVC case number, invoice, and instructions to access CEAC website



Collect and Submit required documents to NVC via CEAC website *



nformation, Applicant receives interview instructions and interview date



exam, register for courier service, gather documents required for interview



Welcome to the United States!

Applicant must enter the US before expiration of visa (usually 6 months) or **BEFORE 21st birthday** (whichever is shorter)



If approved: Passport with IV and sealed packet for CBP given to applicant

Pay USCIS visa fees online for production of LPR card



Interview

Bring: Appointment letter, passport, two passport photos, DS-260 confirmation, suporting docs
