

Mr. Jones has been a United States lawful permanent resident since 2005.<sup>1</sup> Subsequently, Mr. Jones has told Ms. Smith that he has become a U.S. citizen, but Ms. Smith has not been able to confirm whether this is true.

Pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 204.1(g)(3), which states, in relevant part:

“If a self-petitioner filing under section 204(a)(1)(A)(iii), 204(a)(1)(A)(iv), 204(a)(1)(B)(ii), or 204(a)(1)(B)(iii) of the Act is unable to present primary or secondary evidence of the abuser's status, the Service will attempt to electronically verify the abuser's citizenship or immigration status from information contained in Service computerized records. Other Service records may also be reviewed [...]”

Ms. Smith asks that USCIS, pursuant to the above-cited provision, reviews its own records. To assist USCIS in determining Mr. Jones' status, we provide the following information:

With the information described in this section, we believe that we have provided sufficient information to allow USCIS to determine Mr. Jones's immigration status.
